EXECUTIVE ORDER #160

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin May be Flown at Half-Staff in Fond du Lac County as a Mark of Respect for Fond du Lac County Executive Allen J. Buechel

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2022, Fond du Lac County Executive Allen J. Buechel passed away at the age of 74;

WHEREAS, County Executive Buechel served on the Fond du Lac County Board for 17 years;

WHEREAS, County Executive Buechel was elected Fond du Lac County Executive in 1993 and was re-elected to his eighth term in 2021, making him one of the longest serving county executives in the state;

WHEREAS, County Executive Buechel was committed to public service, dedicating nearly half a century as a leader in Fond du Lac County;

WHEREAS, County Executive Buechel's work established him as an effective and accomplished leader at the local, state, and national level; and

WHEREAS, the people of this state join County Executive Buechel's family, friends, colleagues, and all those whose lives were impacted by his service in honoring his memory and mourning his loss.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the Laws of the State, hereby authorize that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin may be flown at half-staff throughout Fond du Lac County beginning at sunrise and ending at sunset on the date(s) determined by Fond du Lac County officials.
